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GENERAL INFORMATION

Accordingly, said Task Order is modified as follows: Overhaul of the Hyperbaric Chamber and Support Systems. Contractors proposal dated 9/3/09 is accepted as proposed and incorporated by reference, with an increased dollar amount of [REDACTED] for additional required work within scope. Period of Performance is extended through 30 June 2010. Acceptance of this modification by the contractor constitutes an accord and satisfaction and represents payment in full for both time and money and for any and all costs, impact effect, and for delays and disruptions arising out of, or incidental to, the work herein revised. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.

The proposed Task Order type will be Firm Fixed Price (FFP).

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SECTION C DESCRIPTIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

See attachment 1 - Statement of Work (SOW).

MOD 1 Statement of Work (SOW) is as follows:

1. Add paragraph 3.2.16, entitled, "EQUIPMENT STORAGE": The contractor shall store all fabricated equipment at the contractor's facility until completion of the research project that was granted to NAMI. The research project is currently not underway and is scheduled to last one year. For estimating purposes, the contractor will estimate the costs of storing the equipment until December 2010.
2. Add paragraph 3.2.17, entitled, "CONSOLE FLAT SCREEN DISPLAYS": The contractor shall install three (3) new console flat screen monitors. Two (2) of the monitors shall be located inside of the console and shall be 12 inches. The third monitor shall be located on top of the console and shall be 19 inches.
3. Add paragraph 3.2.18, entitled, "INTERNAL ENTERTAINMENT VIDEO MONITOR AND OFFGASSING TEST": The contractor shall install a new 7 inch video monitor inside of the chamber at a location accessible for patient viewing, to include all of the proper wiring into the entertainment system. Following completion of the installation, the system shall be placed under pressure for an amount of time determined by the System Certification Authority (SCA). After this allotted time, a gas sample will be taken and tested to Table F4 as stated in SS800-AG-MAN-010/P-9290.
4. Add paragraph 3.2.19, entitled, "CHAMBER HULL TOP COAT": The contractor shall repair any area of the chamber where the painting has been damaged or completely removed. The contractor shall also apply a complete and even top coat to the chamber.
5. Add paragraph 3.2.20, entitled, "FES TANK PRESSURE GAUGE": The contractor shall provide a digital pressure gauge that displays the air pressure supplied to the FES tank. The digital pressure gauge shall be located on the control console.
6. Add paragraph 3.2.21, entitled, "CONSOLE PLEXIGLAS SHELF COVER": The contractor shall provide a properly sized piece of Plexiglas to cover the shelf of the console.
7. Add paragraph 3.2.22, entitled, "STORAGE CONTAINERS": The contractor shall provide two separate storage containers for the control console. The first storage container will be a small cubbie fixed to the left side of the control console shelf. This cubbie will be capable holding pens, grease pens, etc. The second storage container will be a book shelf located on the side of the control console to be determined by NAMI. If the storage container cannot fit on the side of the console, it will be located behind the console operator. The shelves must be sized correctly to hold the proper codes and standard books used by NAMI during diving operations.
8. Add paragraph 3.2.23, entitled, "CO2 SCRUBBER REMOUNT": The contractor shall remount the internal CO2 Scrubber to its proper orientation (horizontally).
9. Add paragraph 3.2.24, entitled, "ICS UNIT DRIP PAN": The contractor shall install a drip pan for

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the Internal Conditioning System Condensation.

10. Add paragraph 3.2.25, entitled, "EXTERNAL CONDITIONING SYSTEM": The contractor shall troubleshoot the existing ECS unit. There is a small leak in the existing system. The contractor shall repair this leak. The entire external unit shall also be inspected and all deficiencies in operation shall be repaired at no cost to the government. The four (4) ball valves in the existing ECS loop shall be replaced with new ball valves.

11. Add paragraph 3.2.26, entitled, "CHAMBER INTERIOR LUG REMOVAL": The contractor shall removed (cut) and grind down one (1) interior chamber lug located on the interior of the inner lock. The lug is located above the bench on the side of the chamber opposite to the console. The contractor shall also grind down a lug that has already been removed (cut) on the side of the chamber adjacent to the console.

12. Add paragraph 3.2.27, entitled, "EKG CONNECTOR BOXES": The contractor shall relocate the current EKG Connection Box to the console side of the chamber. The contractor shall add a 12 lead EKG capability to the current box. If it is not possible to add a 12 lead EKG capability to the current box, the contractor shall use another penetrator on the chamber to add the 12 lead capability.

13. Add paragraph 3.2.28, entitled, "REPLACE CANTY LIGHT TUBES": The contractor shall replace all Canty light tubes located on the chamber.

14. Add paragraph 3.2.29, entitled, "COMPONENT MAINTENANCE LOG BOOKLET": The contractor shall provide a log book, which is comprised of all the certification information for the following components: Gauges, Relief Valves, Flex Hoses, Regulators and Filters.

15. Add paragraph 3.2.30, entitled, "CHAMBER HULL RELIEF VALVE": The chamber hull relief valve listed in the specification is unsatisfactory. The contractor shall provide a properly sized ASME coded relief valve for the chamber hull.

16. Add paragraph 3.2.31, entitled, "BENCH PAD EYES": The contractor shall install a pad eye above each bench located in the inner lock. The pad eyes shall be located above the heads of each bench (closest to the outer lock). The pad eyes shall be large enough for an IV bag clip.

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SECTION D PACKAGING AND MARKING

Packaging and Marking shall be in accordance with Section D of the SeaPort-e Multiple Award Basic Contract. All Deliverables shall be packaged and marked IAW Best Commercial Practice.

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SECTION E INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

Upon completion of all work and final submission of all data items, the contractor's Senior Technical Representative shall prepare and sign a Certificate of Final Acceptance memorandum, and submit it to the TOM for signature. The contractor shall include the fully signed memorandum with its final invoice.

Inspection and Acceptance shall be in accordance with Section E of the SeaPort-e Multiple Award IDIQ Basic Contract for Firm Fixed Price Task Orders. Packaging and Marking shall be in accordance with Section D of the SeaPort-e Multiple Award IDIQ Basic Contract.
